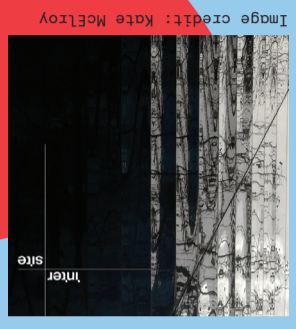

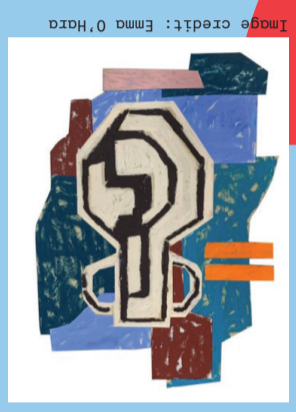

MADE IN CORK MARKET

Four Cork art, design and craft organisations are teaming up once again to celebrate and support local creativity at the former Beamish & Crawford Counting House site in the heart of Cork's medieval quarter.

Sample-Studios, benchspace, Cork Craft & Design and Shandon Art Studios have collectively assembled a jam-packed weekend programme of over 50 art, design and craft events, exhibitions, workshops, demonstrations, screenings and markets to appeal to locals and visitors alike. STAMP event highlights include a market at the Counting House plaza with demos and workshops taking place inside the beautifully restored building throughout Saturday and Sunday; a group art and craft exhibition showcasing the works of local artists and craftspeople from all four organisations, and a light and sound installation presented by Sample-Studios courtesy of art collective INTER_SITE that will illuminate the Counting House by day. Members of the public will be invited to get actively creative with hands-on workshops including screen printing, basket weaving, pottery wheel throwing and felting and also to view pottery throwing, woodturning and oil painting up close in a series of live demos.
